2018 Rutherford Sauvignon Blanc

The release of our 2018 Sauvignon Blanc opens a new chapter for the Red Cap white. At the end of the 2016 season our vineyards source was replanted to cabernet by the owners. Determined to find high quality fruit equal to our previous source, we used the 2017 growing season to sample sauvignon blanc from around the Napa Valley. Our 2018 is from a beautiful vineyard in the Pope Valley area of Napa.

The 2018 Red Cap Sauvignon Blanc is a blend of 91% SB and 9% semillon. Medium straw in color, the wine shows aromas of green apple, honeysuckle and puff pastry. In the mouth the wine is moderately viscous with balanced, juicy acidity and a touch of grip on the finish. Flavors of kiwi, asian pear and grapefruit make this a beauty and the long finish showcases the excellent quality fruit.
